

Result of an Eloement.

An altercation occurred near Dover Bridge on Saturday between Nathaniel Legates and Captain Newlon Andrew which resulted quite seriously. In January last Andrew, it will be remembered, eloped with Legates' wife, but both parties returned shortly afterward, and Mrs. Legates has since been living with her husband. Saturday last Andrew was passing the farm of Legates, and the latter meeting him fired at him, it is charged, with a shotgun, the load entering Andrew's legs and inflicting serious injuries. It is thought, however, that the wounded man will recover. Legates's side of the affair is that Andrew came by visiting and trying to entice the quondam paramour off again; while Andrew says he was stopped in the public road and abused and then shot by Legates. Legates has not been arrested.

James I. Leedum—From Bethlehem to Hog Creek branch; from the corner of Sisk farm to wood wharf road; from Bending's corner to Hog Creek Mill; from Messick's Mill to McCarty's wharf, and all roads between Hog Creek Mill and Fowling Creek and Ganey's wharf.

Owen C. Blades—From Linchester river bridge to Choptank and Preston road.

W. W. Williamson—From Friends' Church to Back Landing.

Thomas H. Flubarty—From Preston to Choptank.

James B. Jones—Friendship, by J. F. Cohee's, road; from J. F. Cohee's corner to Linchester; from Turner's Mill to corner of Geo. Williams' road, and from Friendship to Hynson.

J. F. Hurley—From corner between Joshua Johns and Aaron Johns, by Geo. W. Williams' farm, to road leading from Hynson to Linchester; from Linchester to Preston, and from eanning-house to corner Walter Todd's farm.

Samuel Cornish—From Bethlehem

to Hog Island wharf; from Hog Island road to tan-yard, and from the mouth of Cedar lane to road from tan-yard to Hog Island.

Nathaniel Legates—From Bethlehem to Dover causeway; from tan-yard to wood wharf, and from wood wharf to Holmes's corner.
